

First Capital Group collaborates with IU Health Southern Indiana Physicians' to bring new medical facility to Bloomington.

The new, 12,000-square-foot primary care facility, targeted to open this fall, will be home to six primary care providers. It's expected to see 4,500 to 5,000 patients each year. First Capital is the developer that will lease the facility to IU Health Southern Indiana Physicians, formerly Southern Indiana Medical Group. Bynum Fanyo is the architect, and Tony Fox is the general contractor.

The primary care practice, which will be called IU Health Southern Indiana Physicians-Clarizz Blvd., will provide primary and urgent care. Primary care involves not only treating health problems, but talking to patients about lifestyle choices, prevention and immunizations. Urgent care focuses on treating a specific health problem, such as a sore throat or sinus infection.
